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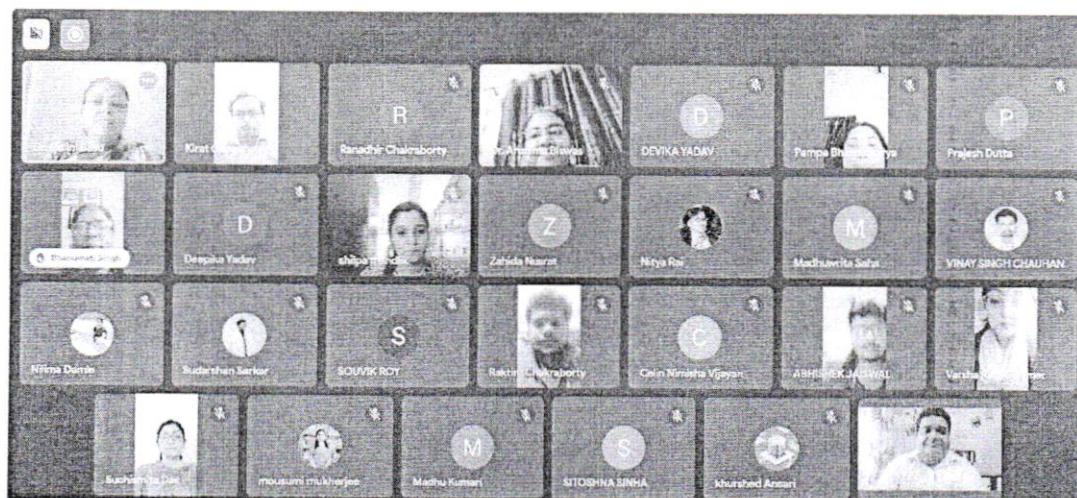

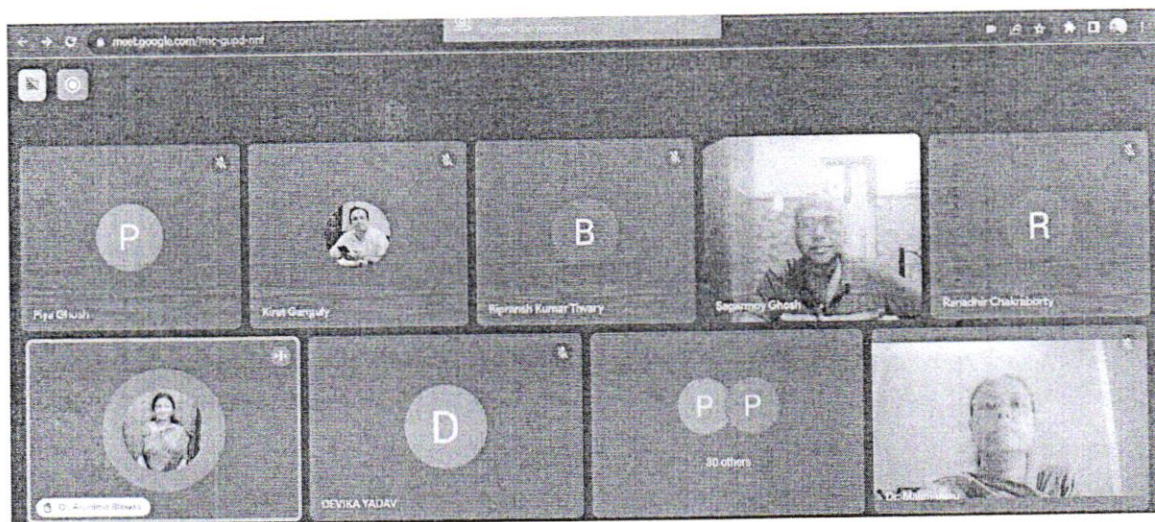

Prof. Chakraborty focused on the role and responsibilities of teachers in NEP. He said that in the near future, critical thinking, digital reformation, artificial intelligence etc. will be the keys to education rather than conventional methodology. He enlightened the participants by sharing advanced and innovative skills that will reform microbiology teaching and to develop the entrepreneurial skills of students. Prof. Ghosh was focused on the opportunities and challenges in the implementation of (Four Year Undergraduate Program (FYUGP) that has been implemented in the universities of West Bengal this year. The webinar was very interactive throughout.


