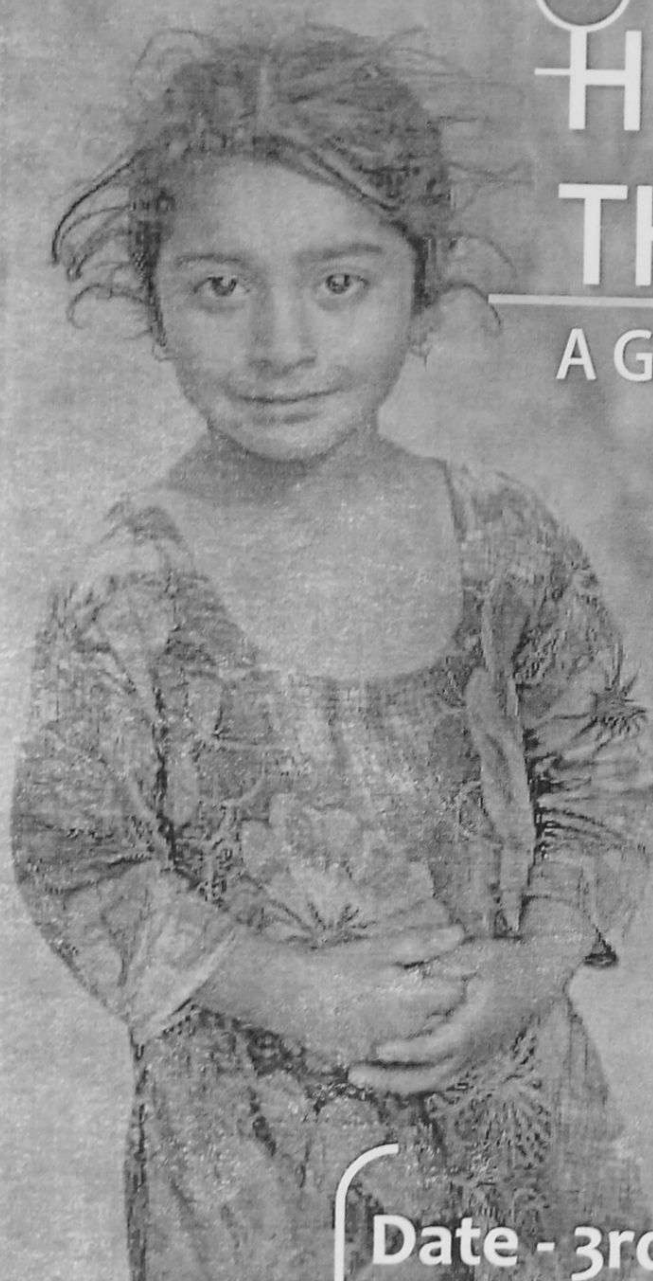



The program began with a welcome address by the convenor Dr.Manika Rakhit followed by an opening address by Principal sir Dr.Satyabrata Sahoo. IQAC coordinator Prof.Sudakshina Sengupta then addressed the audience and welcomed the speaker Dr.Trayee Sinha to deliver her lecture.


Dr.Sinha highlighted how Gender was not a binary concept as we conceive it to be but rather a spectrum. She highlighted how it was necessary to destroy the illusion that there was only one acceptable way to be.

The speaker briefed about the four waves of Feminism that brought about a great change in how women were treated. The 1st wave succeeded in bringing about political rights for women. The 2nd wave brought about social equality. 3rd wave was a critique of Eurocentric feminism, & highlighted the rights of women of 3rd world country & women of colour. 4th wave which was digitally driven focused on equal opportunity for women in all spheres.

The program concluded with an interactive session with the students & faculty members..




