### Report on -- Learn Esperanto Basic Course

Esperanto is a language designed by Dr LudwikLazaras Zamenhof. The word Esperanto means 'a person who hopes'. Zamenh of hoped for equal linguistic opportunity to all the people from different linguistic background. For this purpose, he offered Esperanto to the world in 1887.In 1957 Esperanto was recognised by UNESCO as International Language.

Esperanto grammar is easy to understand and practice. Although Esperanto is dressed with the Roman alphabets its core is universal, more akin to Asian languages. The grammatical endings can be creatively used with the root-words to make sense. 3500 Esperanto root-words are enough to produce 40,000 worda by adding various grammatical endings. In the English vocabulary the "father", "mother", "father in law" etc. take different entries. In Esperanto the only one entry "part" suffices to indicate – "patro"- father, "patrino"- mother, "bopatro"-father in law etc. This informal way to producing sentences trains the students in such a way that their outlook on languages would soon change. It is enriched with the clariy like an European language. It will help the students learn other languages easily and fast. It provides the students with worldwide opportunities of friendship, education and tourism.

Esperanto is taught in thousands of colleges and institutions across the world. Millions of Esperanto speakers criss-cross the world speaking. If anyone be an Esperantist, he or she can meet the foreigner, can exchange ideas and if he or she is a frequent traveller they can stay with them. So Esperanto help to live in a world without borders.

The department of Bengali organized a seminar on Esperanto to observe the hundred years of death anniversary year of Dr Zamenhof on 26<sup>th</sup> April,2017 followed by a workshop on Esperanto on 15<sup>th</sup> December, 2017 on the eve of the birthday of Dr Zamenhof. Since the language is taught as a part of the Linguistic paper in Presidency and other universities the department started teaching Basic Esperanto course to the departmental students.

In 2020-21 the department offered the Basic course to all the departments of the college, specially to the language departments of Honours Course. 26 students enrolled their names and 20 students completed the course.

In 2021-22 also the department planned to offer this course for both odd semester and even semester students that means for two times in the session. In this session (even semester) 97 Students had enrolled their names and 90 students completed the course successfully.

This time the course was conducted in two phases, one was from 8<sup>th</sup> February, 2022 to 14<sup>th</sup> February, 2022 and the other was from 2<sup>nd</sup> March,2022 to 9<sup>th</sup> March,2022.All the classes were done in online mode through google meet.

Members of Federation Esperanto of Bharat and Kolkata took the most strenuous job to teach the language in so short-term course. Mr. Shyam Sundar Pal eminent Esperantist and writer, Mr. A.K.Nandy, skilled teacher, Mr. Samaresh Chakraborty, secretary of FEB-Kalkato and Dr Sovona Ghosh, the Head of the Dept. took the classes almost everyday in the evening when the scheduled college classes were over. They successfully gave the lessons to know the 16<sup>th</sup> rules of E-to grammar, gave the taste of E-to literature from original writings and translated version. Even the time was not sufficient for learn any language deeply but it is Esperanto which is so feasible instrument of communication that some of the students learnt to speak fluently.

It is our initial endeavour from which we gain experience to begin more effective and time-consuming course.


